### What is JA Inspire?

JA Inspire is a powerful, interactive experience for eighth-grade students. It will enable you to virtually interact with local business professionals and explore many different types of careers. JA Inspire allows companies to come together to represent careers for you to explore and see the connection to your future!

You will be introduced to careers in the following eight industry categories, which are also referred to as "<u>career clusters</u>" or "<u>industry clusters</u>." # **How Will JA Inspire Benefit Me?**

JA Inspire is a platform for you to get information about careers you find interesting. You will have the chance to watch career videos, visit virtual career booths, take part in webinars, and download career information to learn more about careers you are interested in. You will also learn about various high school program options that are specific to Collier County. After participating in JA Inspire, you will have a better idea of the high school courses you'd like to sign up for, according to your career interests and personal strengths. Through the JA Build Your Future app, you and your parents will be able to calculate the cost of post-secondary education required to achieve the career you want, as well as your future earning potential/income and your ability to pay for the cost of attaining the necessary education. You will learn that the level of education you receive will usually have a large impact on your future income. We hope you will feel INSPIRED to set new goals (and achieve them!) after you have completed this learning experience.

### **How Do I Use This Guide?**

- As a digital workbook for the JA Inspire program.
- To connect your personal career interests and strengths to high school and <u>post-secondary</u> (college, university, or trade school) program options.
- To review key terms that will help you plan for your future. Every time you see a word or phrase that looks <u>like</u> <u>this</u>, you will know it is an important term. All <u>keywords</u> and <u>phrases</u> can be found in the glossary at the end of this student guide.

### **How is JA Inspire Different this Year?**


Due to COVID-19, Junior Achievement will not be hosting an onsite (in-person) Career Expo this year. Instead, the JA Inspire Career Expo will take place online, as an exciting virtual experience! As you go through this program, you may notice references to in-person interactions. While your JA Inspire interactions this year will be virtual, it is important for you to consider how to present yourself professionally both on and off the screen. Eventually, face-to-face (or in-person) interactions will once again be common. After completing JA Inspire, you will be able to use the knowledge you've acquired for any type of communication: virtual AND in-person!

### **Pre-Session: Getting Ready**

You must create your account on the vFairs platform and complete the pre-event survey before moving on to Session One. Doing this will earn you 25 points towards your chance to win a FREE LAPTOP! You will have more opportunities to earn points when you participate in the JA Inspire Career Expo on March 24<sup>th</sup>.

- Step 2: Click the *login* button in the upper right-hand corner of your screen. Click "New User? Register Now"
- **Step 3**: Provide the required information to create your account. Please note, "*Student ID*" is your schoolissued ID Number, and "*Email*" is your school-issued email address.
- **Step 4**: Login and complete the pre-event survey. Now you are ready to begin your career exploration adventure! Your teacher will guide you through this workbook to prepare you for your visit to the virtual Career Expo on March 24<sup>th</sup>.




# **Session One Activity: Career Assessment**

### Please follow the instructions below (ask your teacher if you need assistance creating your account):

- 1.Go to <a href="https://mycareershines.kuder.com/">https://mycareershines.kuder.com/</a>
- 2. Click "Create an account", at the top of the screen. Then click "I am a middle or high school student"
- 3. Select your current grade level and your high school graduation year from the drop-down options. Then select your school type (public or private).
- 4. Next, select the county, "Collier County Public Schools" and your school name from the drop-down options.
- 5. Complete all required information in Step 2 of 4.
- 6. Complete the username and password information required in Step 3 of 4.
- 7. Complete the information required for Step 4 of 4. Then click, "Sign Me Up".
- 8. Click on the, "Take an Assessment" link on the left of the screen.
- 9. Next, click "Begin" under the Kuder Career Interests Assessment® section.
- 10. After you complete your assessment, you will be able to begin exploring potential career paths that you match up with!


# **Session Two Activity: Digital Career Book**

**Directions**: Follow the steps below to complete this activity.

- Go to <a href="https://career.ja.org">https://career.ja.org</a> from your phone, tablet, or computer.
- Please note, the website will take up to one minute to load.
- Tap or click on "Career Inventory" on the left-hand side.
- Tap or click on "Take the inventory" to launch the Career Interest Quiz.
- Select your level of interest for each task. When you are done with each section, click "Next" to continue.
- When you have reached the final page, click "Submit" to get your results!
- You will be shown a list of careers that match your personality.
- You can then view salary ranges, required skills, educational requirements, and local employers for each career.

# **Session Three Activity: Crafting the Elevator Pitch**

As you begin to research careers and talk with professional mentors, it is important to make a good first impression. A central part of creating a good first impression is the ability to present yourself in a meaningful way. An <u>elevator pitch</u> is an excellent way to accomplish this. This pitch is all about you: who you are, what you do, and what you want to do. Your <u>elevator pitch</u> is a way to share your expertise and credentials quickly and effectively with people who do not know you.

It is important to think about what you want to say before you deliver your <u>elevator pitch</u>. Use the space below to brainstorm answers to the following questions to prepare some possible ideas for your <u>elevator pitch</u>.



## Session Four: What to Expect at the JA Inspire Career Expo

In this session, you will set goals that will help you get the most out of your time at the JA Virtual Inspire Career Expo.

- Being a virtual JA Inspire attendee offers you the opportunity to seek information about certain careers, industries, and <u>career clusters</u>. During your participation in JA Inspire, you will learn about your strengths and interests which will help lead you to a fulfilling career.
- Over 40 local businesses, within many of the 8 <u>career clusters</u>, will have virtual booths with career and company information, videos, pamphlets, and more.
- You will have the opportunity to visit as many booths as you would like.
- Your virtual backpack allows you to collect information from the booths and access it at a later date.
   You will have access to the entire <u>career fair</u> for 90 days after the event. Make sure to revisit the event and share the information with your parents and/or caregivers!
- Webinars will be available in the virtual auditorium throughout the day.
- A Laptop computer will be awarded to the student with the most points, so make sure to attend the webinars, fill out the pre-and post-survey, and visit all the booths.
- JA Inspire can be completed while in school or while you are working remotely.





### VIRTUAL LOBBY

You will enter through the virtual lobby, which includes access to the following:

- Company Banners: Click on the banner to go directly to the company's career booth
- o **Auditorium**: Watch webinars on career topics
- Exhibit Halls: Find company booths within the exhibit hall

There is an exhibitor index that allows you to easily find companies by name. Or scroll through the businesses, stopping by to visit and get information.

### VIRTUAL BOOTHS

You will visit booths that have videos, pamphlets, flyers, pictures, career stories, and Day in the Life videos.

# **Glossary of Key Words & Phrases**

As you fill in your JA Inspire Student Guide, you will see some of the following keywords and phrases. Be sure to review the definition of each term every time you see it in your Student Guide.

<u>Career Fair</u>: An event where employers offer information about their companies to people who are looking for (or interested in learning about) their offered jobs. Also referred to as Career Expo.

<u>Career/Industry Clusters</u>: Groups of similar and related firms in a defined geographic area that share common markets, technologies, worker skill needs, and which are often linked by buyer-seller relationships.

<u>Career Planning</u>: Identifying the choices that need to be made to get started towards a chosen career path. Career planning is a continuous process of thinking about your interests, values, skills, and preferences; exploring the life, work, and learning options available to you; ensuring your work fits with your circumstances.

<u>Career Plan</u>: A list of short and long term goals along with the actions needed to achieve these goals. Career plans help you make decisions about what classes to take and helps identify those extracurricular activities, research, and internships that will make you a strong job candidate.

**<u>Earning Potential</u>**: The amount of money a person should be able to earn in his or her professional capacity. It often refers to the top salary for a particular field or profession.

<u>Elevator Pitch</u>: A short but effective explanation of who you are, what you do, and what you want to do. The elevator pitch is a way to share your expertise and credentials quickly and effectively with people who don't know you.

**<u>Hard Skills</u>**: Required job skills that are acquired through formal education and training programs.

<u>High-Demand/High-Growth Job</u>: The amount of need there is for a job in an industry. For example, as the population gets older, the job demand for those who work with the elderly increases.

<u>High-Wage Job</u>: A job in an industry or occupation in which the average wage is at least 50% higher than the overall average.

<u>Postsecondary</u>: Any education completed after high school graduation (usually referenced in regard to college or trade school).

**ROI (Return on Investment)**: A performance measure used to evaluate the efficiency of an investment. To calculate, the benefit (or return) of an investment is divided by the cost of the investment.

**Skill Set**: A particular category of knowledge, abilities, and experience necessary to perform a job.

**Soft Skills**: The personal attributes you need to succeed in the workplace (also known as people skills).

### Examples:

- <u>Strong Work Ethic</u> You are motivated to complete a job and will go the extra mile to make sure that happens. You are conscientious and will always strive to do your very best.
- Positive Attitude You are optimistic, upbeat, and have a positive outlook.
- Flexible You can adapt to challenges and new situations quickly and embrace them along the way.
- Time Management Capability You prioritize tasks, use your time wisely, and can work on several projects at the same time.
- <u>Good Communication Skills</u> You are a good listener, and you are articulate. You can communicate in a manner that builds relationships with vendors, customers, and colleagues.













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
